Dear Mr. Keown:

The Indiana Commission on Proprietary Education has reviewed the information concerning your institution. Publicly funded institutions are exempt from regulation by the Indiana Commission.

Specifically, Indiana Code 21-17-1-13 states in part "...The following are not considered to be postsecondary proprietary educational institutions under this chapter:"

(1) A state educational institution or another educational institution established by law and financed in whole or part by public funds.

The commission has reviewed the materials submitted, and determined that the Technical College System of Georgia is excluded from regulation in accordance with IC 21-17-1-13.

Should any changes in the institution's Indiana presence occur the commission should be notified prior to implementation. At that time a further review of the institution's status will be conducted.
